NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs. Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.

The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone who is not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial. **Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.**

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

****Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.** Dogs can be registered online at: <http://nadac.com/afm/dogregfrm.asp>

AS OF JANUARY 2014: Dogs must enter the Veterans Division after their 9th birthday. Dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division after their 12th birthday.

NON-JUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER: Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

Skilled/Proficient Categories: Dogs must be entered in one category, either the Skilled or Proficient, for the entire weekend. All dogs entered in the Skilled category must take a 4" jump height reduction. For additional information on Proficient and Skilled categories, please refer to the NADAC Rulebook online at <http://www.nadac.com>

Dogs must be on leash at all times (except during runs and in the warm-up area). **Please clean up after your dogs.**
PLEASE DO NOT LET YOUR DOG POTTY ON THE BUILDING.

Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.

The management will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

Refund Policy: Dogs may be withdrawn from one or more classes and receive a full refund provided written notification is given to the trial secretary by March 24, 2018. After March 24th, refunds will only be granted for bitches in heat, ill/injured dogs or handlers, and otherwise ineligible dogs/handlers. In such cases, a refund of entry fees, less \$3.00 per run to cover secretary, recording, & judges fees, will be returned provided the trial secretary is given written notification prior to the beginning of judging for the day.

Facility: This trial is being held indoors on dirt surface. There is limited crating indoors, use of ex-pens indoors will be dependent on entries. There is ample crating space outside the arena with limited shade. Safe, non-tipping propane heaters may be used in the crating area. Fresh cedar shavings may be present in the arena.

Obstacles: The following obstacles may be used in this trial: open tunnel, winged jumps, non-winged jumps, matted A-frame, matted dog walk, weave poles (24" spacing), barrels and hoops.

Check-Ins: Contestants only need to check in once. See page 1 for check-in, walk-through, and first run times.

Measuring: Measurement forms may be obtained at <http://nadac.com/Application-for-Permanent-Height-Card.htm>

Dogs which require measuring: Dogs in the Proficient Category, Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16"

Dogs which do not need to be measured: 1) Dogs jumping 16" in the Veteran or Junior Handler Division; 2) Dogs jumping 20; 3) Dogs in the Skilled Category; 4) Dogs with a permanent height card; 5) Dogs listed on the Height Exemption List

If not already on file, please send a copy of your permanent height card with your entry.

Move-ups: Move-ups will be accepted until 1 hour after the last class of the day before the move-up. Please notify the trial secretary in writing of all move-ups ASAP.

Awards/Prizes: Placement ribbons will be awarded to at least 4th place in each jump height for each class, in each category, except Chances, which is a pass/fail class. A purple qualifying ribbon shall be given for each qualifying round in each class. Title ribbons will be available for each title completed at this trial. A rosette will be awarded to any dog earning their NATCH at the trial. Please notify the trial secretary if you expect to earn a NATCH at this trial.

Volunteers: A volunteer sign-up schedule will be available at check-in. Please volunteer to help at the trial!

Food: Saturday and Sunday lunches will be provided free-of-charge to volunteers and club members, donations will be accepted from all others. Additionally, there are several restaurants located within 5 miles of the trial site.

On-site Camping: Overnight camping for tent campers and RV's is available for \$10 per night (no hookups).

Trial Photography: Handlers are welcome to take pictures and videos of their dogs at the trial. No flashes are allowed. Photographers wishing to be designated as the Official Trial Photographer to take pictures for sale must be approved by the Trial Chair prior to taking photographs. Only one Official Trial Photographer will be allowed at any given trial. Official Trial Photographers must respect all handler requests regarding taking photographs of said handler and their dog(s).

Directions to Hoodoo Arena:

4913 Bittrich-Antler Rd, Deer Park, WA 99006

From I-90: Take the Division Street exit and head north through Spokane on Division/Hwy 395. Continue north on Hwy 395 to Deer Park. After you reach Deer Park, turn left (west) on Monroe at the third exit (Monroe/Crawford, midway between MM 180 & 181). Go approximately 1 mile to Antler Road. Turn right (west) on Antler Rd. Continue on Antler Road 3.5 miles to the stop sign at Williams Valley Rd, then continue on straight for another ¾ mile. Arena is located on the left (south) side of the road.

From Newport: Take Hwy 2 south to Deer Park-Milan Road at the stoplight in Riverside. Turn right (west) on Deer Park-Milan Road and drive to Deer Park. Be sure to note speed limit signs when you enter Deer Park! Continue straight through Deer Park (you are now on Crawford). Cross Hwy 395 (you are now on Monroe Rd) and go approx 1 mile to Antler Road. Turn right (west) on Antler Rd. Continue on Antler Road 3.5 miles to the stop sign at Williams Valley Rd (you are now on Bittrich-Antler Rd), then continue on straight for another ¾ mile. Arena is located on the left (south) side of the road.

From Colville: Take Hwy 395 south to Williams Valley Road (midway between MM 185 & 186, across from mini-storage and "Owl Fence"). Turn right (west) on Williams Valley Road. After about ¾ mile, Williams Valley makes a 90 degree turn left (south). Stay on Williams Valley Road heading south for another 3.5 miles to Bittrich-Antler Road. Turn right (west) on Bittrich-Antler Road. Go approximately ¾ mile. Arena is located on the left (south) side of the road.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs his agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council LLC, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, as explained in the current Exhibitors Handbook, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these. Exhibitor/owner further agrees to abide by all trial & facility rules & regulations.
- Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, employees and members), Hoodoo Howlers (including its officers, directors, members and event organizing committee), Hoodoo Enterprises, LLC (including officers, agents and employees) and Dorothy Bowers and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
