

Hoodoo Arena Open Practice Session Policies & Rules

Facility Info:

- Ring: 80 x 100' fully fenced indoor ring with dirt surface
- Available agility equipment: A-frame, Dog walk, Open tunnels, Single jumps, Double jump, Displaceable tire jump, Table. Teeter is available on request.
- Surveillance cameras: Please anticipate that surveillance cameras will be in use at this facility

- Arena hours (Sept 1 – Oct 22, 2023):
Wednesday - Sunday: 10 am – 6 pm.

- Arena rental by reservation ONLY. Reservations may be made by emailing [Dorothy](#).
- Reservations requests must include: Name of Handler(s), Name of Dog(s), Desired Date/Time of reservation.
- Reservations cancelled with less than 24 hours notice will be charged a flat \$10 cancellation fee. Cancellation fees must be paid before additional reservations will be accepted.
- Payments can be made by cash or check upon arrival

General Policies:

- All handlers must be experienced and knowledgeable on obstacle performance. Reservations from handlers with no agility experience will not be accepted for open practice.
- Unless specifically approved by management, no training of dogs owned by third parties
- Absolutely NO offering lessons to others handlers. Handlers may assist each other in training but may not receive compensation for said assistance.
- All handlers, family members, guardians of minors, spectators, friends, and guests that enter the premises must sign a liability waiver. Please inform [Dorothy](#) when making the reservation if you plan to bring a guest.

- NO SMOKING on the premises

Facility Rules:

Dogs:

- Dogs may not be tied to any object. Please use crates when dogs are not actively being trained.
- No loose dogs in aisles
- No loose dogs in parking areas
- Dogs must be under handler's control at all times
- No aggressive dogs allowed on the premises
- All dogs must be current on rabies vaccinations
- Do not let your dog potty in the arena, on the arena building or on equipment
- Pick up your dog's waste and deposit in designated containers
- No bitches in season allowed on premises

Obstacles:

- All tunnels must be securely bagged on both ends.
- Obstacles may be left on course after practice.
- Obstacles labeled as competition only may not be used for practice.
- Obstacles may be moved unless a NADAC VT course has been set for the day

NADAC Video Taped Courses

Occasionally a day may be set aside for running NADAC VT courses.

- The current plan is to set (3) ELITE VT courses; one will be set the previous evening and be available until noon. At noon, Elite Regular will be set and that course and its reversal will be available to run for the rest of the day. Handlers can number/reverse the Regular courses as they choose, but equipment is otherwise not to be moved.
- Cost will be \$5.00 for up to 10 minutes in the ring. Handlers can practice or do the VT course, they just have to limit their time in the ring to 10 minutes.
- Handlers must provide their own videographer and are responsible for submitting their runs to NADAC
- The electronic timers will be set up to start when handlers enter the ring and stop when exiting.
- VT runs/practice sessions will be available on a drop-in basis
- All handlers and guests must sign a liability waiver.
